Participation may offer you or future generations hope of improved platelet disorder therapies. There is no charge for study-related tests.

- Thrombocytopenia Absent Radius Syndrome (TAR)

We are interested in understanding how your cells build platelet sacs and how things can go wrong to cause these syndromes and other related disorders. We can do this by having you come into the hospital and doing some tests. Travel assistance is available.
